## Curtin VPSC Spring into Summer Carnival, Sunday 28th November

Please park in the overflow carpark behind the main car parking area and under the trees to the right of the centre.

Entry from 8am - use the main entrance to Aqualife. Entrance for swimmers is \$3.80 and \$2.00 for spectators – correct change or small notes are appreciated for payment – or EFT available. We ask that big clubs leave the middle section of the grassed area (under the trees) for small groups without shade shelters. Programs available for \$5.00 - these will be available as you walk in to the outdoor pool area and cash is required. Or they can purchased on the raffle tables next to the curved wall.

The carnival will start at 8.45am with the 800m heats. There will be an opportunity for these swimmers to cool down after the event. Please have time keepers in place ready to go. Timekeeping has been a challenge as there are many clubs with a very small number of competitors. Please make sure you fulfill your time keeping allocation as it is important to the swimmers to get official times, and we all want the meet to run on time. The view on pool deck is certainly the best. The timekeeping roster is in the program. The timekeeping roster has been developed based on all entries Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> November. Any changes past this date have not been taken into account.

Splash and Dash swimmers – welcome! Your events are between 9.15 and 12.00. We have dedicated people to help you – look for the people in yellow High Vis vest. If you do not have a club please come and sit with the Vic Park team – our coaches are there to assist. Don't forget to grab your certificates at the end of your swim. If you think your child is incorrectly enrolled in the S and D please find a Board member or enquire at the marshalling tent to see if we can move them into the regular event they should be in (no promises though!).

Bacon and egg burgers will be ready from 8am. Burgers etc will be available for lunch. Our Ruby Girl coffee van will be on site for caffeine hits.
