- 28 days after the date of a satisfactory competency assessment

You will then have the option of Personal Public Liability and Professional Indemnity Industry Insurance which can be purchased through ASCTA – our insurance broker – AIA – $1800\ 277\ 624$

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL): Some potential Students may be able to satisfy all or some of the competency requirements for accreditation without having to attend the full formal course. An RPL application kit can be downloaded from ascta.com if you think this applies to you.

To participate, Students:

- ⇒ must complete this Enrolment which includes the ASCTA General Membership Registration Once Accredited and Prohibited Person Declaration, then send with full payment to the Course Administrator at least one week prior to the Practical Induction commencement date
- must study and answer the questions on the SAT Online platform emailed to you and watch the Living with Water DVD
- ⇒ observe and log 5 hours (at least 1 ½ hours mandatory) of swimming and water safety lessons
- should obtain a medical clearance prior to participating in the practical activity components of the course if any concerns exist about the low level of fitness required

Students must bring to the Practical Induction:

- ⇒ the Swim Australia™ Teacher Theory Acknowledgement printed from the online theory
- ⇒ photo ID
- swimwear, as you will be required to participate and be assessed at the Practical Induction (all skills will be taught to you at the course)(basic fitness level needed)

To be accredited, a Student must:

- ⇒ attend all sessions
- ⇒ be deemed competent in the practical assessments
- ⇒ be at least 17 years of age
- ⇒ provide a Theory Acknowledgement

After the course:

- provide a satisfactory On the Job Competency Assessment (25 hours estimated to attain competency)
- ⇒ attach lesson plans developed for the On the Job Competency Assessment
- ⇒ fully complete all sections of the Accumulative Training Record within 12 months
- provide a current Working with Children Check (if 18yo or older and Australian resident)

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Payment, Refunds, Transfers & Course Cancellations:

Full payment must be included when enrolling. You will be enrolled for the course when your payment is cleared.

Your Course Administrator must be contacted **prior to the course commencement** if you are unable to attend the course. If the Course Administrator is administering another course at a suitable time and venue for you, you *may* be able to transfer to this course. Otherwise refunds will incur a 25% administration fee.

Courses may be cancelled for a variety of reasons, at the Course Administrator's discretion. In this event, a full refund of your course fee will be provided once course resources are returned in an as new state. Because of this unlikely possibility, it is suggested that you consider separate insurance should you have accommodation and/or travel expenses.
